## The solidarity network for homelessness



At Plein Milieu, we believe that individuals should never be considered problems, and that each person should be allowed to fulfill themselves in society. However, for people who are homeless or who use drugs, every day is a fight for survival.

Having confirmed the favorable impact of a positive relationship between establishments and people in the street, we saw the relevance of creating L'Oranger.

**L'Oranger is a network that responds to the issues surrounding homelessness and cohabitation in the Plateau-Mont-Royal by forging relationships between all the players in the community. It relies on dialogue and the understanding of others to prevent social estrangement.**

## HOW DOES IT WORK?

**Homelessness affects everyone. In this regard, we all have a role to play.**

## The role of establishments

**Socially responsible establishments** offer free services that meet the needs of people experiencing homelessness. They create relationships with them by welcoming them to their establishments.

## Professional support

**Social mediation workers** support the involvement of establishments by offering training, supervision and regular follow-ups.

**Plein Milieu takes care of the visibility** of establishments and provides them with a solid network and effective promotional tools.

## Citizen contribution

**Citizens demonstrate their solidarity** by going to or exercising their purchasing power in member establishments that act according to common values. **They encourage inclusiveness** by reaching out to people experiencing homelessness by going to places where they are welcome.

**Two participants who have experienced or are experiencing homelessness** occupy the role of Sowers. They get involved as ambassadors by feeding the project with their knowledge and experience of the community and by promoting the network's services.
